Women's Solidarity Luncheon: The Honolulu City & County Committee on the Status of Women is sponsoring a luncheon on January 31, 1981, at the Ilikai Hotel, \$8.75 per person, 11:00 a.m. no host cocktails and luncheon to follow at noon. The purpose of the luncheon is to share information about each organization's purpose, functions, and services offered and also to organize several of the organizations to coordinate legislative efforts. Women's Network: The Women's Round Table, in cooperation with the Continuing Committee of the National Women's Conference and the State Office of Affirmative Action, met on January 6, 1981, with representatives of many womens groups to discuss establishing a network for the purpose of affording women more immediate access to local news of interest at short notice, especially as the new legislative session begins. Suggestions were discussed as to the implementation of the network (for example: a telephone tree, a code-a-phone to relate tape messages, weekly bulletins, etc.). The AAUW announced that there was grant money available to obtain a code-a-phone and other related expenses.
