Appointments To Charter Revision Commission, County of Honolulu. Mayor Eileen Anderson will be making appointments to the Charter Revision Commission. The language of the Charter reflects certain sexist attitudes that are outmoded. Some of the language has caused problems for the Mayor in making appointments, especially where men are specifically required. Any woman attorney interested in being appointed to this Commission should write to the Mayor and enclose a resume.
