AGENDA: Proposed HWL Agenda for 1983 Legislative Session for Review and Comment by General Membership

The purpose of the November meeting is to discuss the topics of legislation which HWL will participate in during the 1983 legislative session. A wide range of topics* will be discussed, and, hopefully, members will provide the Committee on Legislation and the Board with comments. In December, the Committee on Legislation and the Board will decide which areas HWL will pursue and it is the goal of the Committee and the Board that the areas chosen are representative of the wishes and opinions of the HWL members. In addition, the revised organization of the Committee on Legislation will be discussed.

Over ten topics will be presented by either special speakers or members of the Committee on Legislation. Due to the high volume of material, we ask that you arrive promptly at noon. We will begin the program at 12:10 pm. If you plan to purchase luncheon, please arrive early.

In order to ensure that all topics are covered, questions will be reserved until after the presentations. Comment forms will be distributed at the beginning of the meeting and we encourage members to be liberal with their comments. The comment form will include space for feedback regarding the September and October meetings on Child Care, and on Child Abuse and Neglect.

The board is considering which lobbying groups HWL may work with during the legislative session. Suggestions are welcome.

* Topics: Budget, sexual assault, sexual harassment, probate code, prostitution, women and prison, ERA compliance, elderly women, insurance, employment, maternity parental benefits, women in sports, AFDC.
