Comparable Worth: The 1984 Legislature passed S.B. 2119, as amended, which establishes a temporary commission to study comparable worth. Commission members include both management and union representatives. The legislative auditor will serve as the chair of the commission and will provide the necessary administrative staff.

The commission will conduct an evaluation of the classification and compensation systems that determine state and county wages and make a recommendation for a job evaluation system that would implement comparable worth for public employees in Hawaii. The Commission is to prepare preliminary findings for submission before the 1985 legislature with a final report to be prepared for submission to the 1986 legislature.

The HWL Legislative Committee testified in support of the legislation and intends to monitor the work of the Commission and to study the issue further. Anyone interested in working on the issue of comparable worth should contact either Sherry Broder (531-6202) or Dona Hanaike (548-8929).
