AGENDA: "Career Opportunities in Government Agencies"

The July monthly meeting will be a panel discussion on career opportunities for attorneys in federal, state and city and county government agencies. HWL has invited representatives from the offices of the Federal Public Defender, U.S. Attorney, JAG Corp., Federal Bureau of Investigation, Attorney General, Prosecuting Attorney, Public Defender and Corporation Counsel to speak on the various positions available in their department, and address the application procedures, qualifications, salary and benefits for those positions.

As of press time, the invitation to speak had been accepted by: Daniel Bent, U.S. Attorney, Michael R. Levine, Federal Public Defender, Mike Lilly, Attorney General, Colonel Franklin Wright, JAG Corp. and representative from prosecutor's office.

The purpose of the panel discussion is to provide HWL members with information about career opportunities and the Board hopes that this panel will be the first of many to provide information on employment options available to women attorneys in Hawaii.
