Linda Chu Takayama was appointed the Insurance Commissioner for the State of Hawaii on December 16, 1991. As chief regulator of the state's insurance industry, she is responsible for application and enforcement of Hawaii's insurance code with regard to insurance companies admissions, rates and financial examinations, as well as the licensing of individual agents. Ms. Takayama supervises a staff of 37, who provide guidance, assistance and education to consumers on matters related to insurance.
